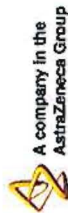

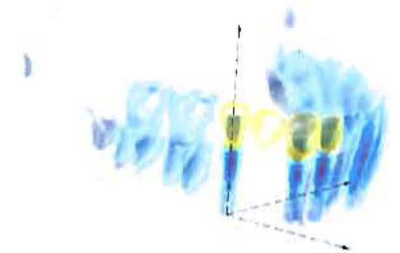

Description

Over the past several years while treating implant patients, Dr. Jensen has encountered cases in which treatment planning has been extremely difficult. Problems with most cases are anatomically related. When these patients are encountered during surgery they can lead to some embarrassing situations and "surgical surprises". Dr. Jensen now employs the use of computer-guided treatment planning software to assist him with diagnosis, treatment planning and fabrication of surgical guides. The use of iCAT scan for diagnosing dental problems that may otherwise go undetected by routine panorex examination or periapical radiograph will also be discussed.

Objectives

At the conclusion of the seminar, participants will be able to:

- Realize the advantages of the iCAT scan in treatment planning of implant cases and computer-guided surgery.
- Recognize the application of various procedures to augment alveolar ridges and develop ideal implant recipient sites.
- Understand utilization of the iCAT as a diagnostic aid when routine radiographs are not helpful.
